



Case Study – London SE20 7UF

Brief – A double fronted Victorian house which required conversion of a conservatory into a home office, re-instatement of original external first floor extension, enlargement of kitchen utility space and shower room.

Scheme Design – The conventional sloping roof was rejected in favour of a glazed timber framed gable arrangement which allowed natural light to penetrate deep into the centre of the house. Where possible openings within the new extensions were maximised by installing double glazed doors, fixed glazed panels and roof lights.

Scope of Work - Produce fully detailed CAD drawings for submission of full planning and building control applications, with detailed specifications, cost spread sheets and outline programme. On successful receipt of local authority approvals project management, cost reporting and supervise the building works through to completion
